Hello Parents and Guardians of Notre Dame Catholic Secondary School

I would like to take this time to introduce myself as the new Principal coming in September 2017.

I am extremely happy to be able to serve the Notre Dame School community. Notre Dame's reputation is very strong in the Brampton community, and I want to formally thank John Lezon for his seven years of commitment and dedication to the school.

Some reminders as we enter the summer, but also approach the new school year.

By choosing to attend Notre Dame Catholic Secondary School, students and their parents/guardians have made a serious and long-term commitment to comply with the school uniform as set by the Board and the school. The school is committed to maintaining the uniform standards in order to reflect the Catholic ideals represented in our school and to contribute to the creation of a safe school environment.

Uniform Expectations:

- Black McCarthy dress pants. Imitations or non- McCarthy are not permitted.
- Long Sleeve Notre Dame Crested Rugby Sweater and Notre Dame Golf Shirt are mandatory.
- Solid black dress shoes and or Solid black casual shoes- closed toe, closed heel, laces are to be black only. No other colours or brand logos, no striping or markings are permitted to be visible. NO BOOTS.
- Black, white, or gray socks must be worn with all Black shoes. Pants are not to be tucked in socks or footwear.
- Students are to be in full uniform every day at all times.
- Coats, hoodies, jackets, or sweaters are not to be worn in the building during the day.
- The only acceptable T-shirts that are to be worn under shirts are plain white.
- Baseball caps, hats, and bandanas are not to be worn in the building during the school day. Female students can wear a **black only** scarves for their hair that are no more than 2 inches or 5 cm in width.
- All pants are to be worn at the waist
- Pants are to be hemmed to proper ankle length.

Parents and guardians are advised that students must come to school with the full uniform as outlined.

Those that do not, parents and guardians will be communicated with and their son/daughter will be sent home in order to comply.

I look forward to meeting the students, parents and guardians and establishing a strong school home partnership.
