Exam Preparation - Exam Success

Exams: Exams are nothing more than big unit tests. Each grade 9 or 10 exam is only 90 minutes long, which is only 10 minutes longer than class. Proper preparation is key for success. Exams will be made up of past unit tests. Review vocabulary of each unit. Review all past unit reviews. EXAMS make up anywhere from 10-20% of your final mark....they can make a difference between pass and fail or between 50's and 60's or 70's to 80's.

<u>Study TIPS:</u> Study in shorter intervals. 3 - 40 minute periods with breaks is better than 2 hours straight. *Turn off PHONE and TV*, eliminate distractions. Study at a table not on your bed. Plan the most time for your hardest subject. Build any vocabulary list and review it. Write and rewriteexperts say 7 times to memorize

Repetition gives birth to perfection, the more you repeat the better you know. Always try to study with pen, paper and your own voice, say things out loud. The more ways your brain works at something the better you will learn it.

Engage in positive self-talk: Never say you cannot do something. Always tell yourself that yes you can do it. Never call yourself stupid or give up. Remember the story of the Little Engine that could......I think I can, I think I can, I think I can.....Believe in yourself, God does.

Writing Exams: Proven Tips for Success

- ▶ #1 Name #2 Short term memory Dump #3 READ the whole exam #4 Pay attention to the long answer question. Read with your pen in hand. Underline or circle key words. #5 Start writing exam
- ▶ The higher the mark the more information is required.

Do the easier questions first – build your confidence.

Write on the exam paper

- Circle key words
- ∘ Jot down any immediate ideas for longer writing pieces as you read the exam or as you do the multiple choice
- Put down any memorized lists on the top or back of the exam once you are allowed to begin, so you do not forget

Look for any hints in the exam, hints are often found in the multi-guess section. Answer every multiple choice question.

- ▶ Use a blank sheet of paper beside your exam to record any ideas or to do any rough work or sketches or write down what you have memorized. Example: **lists or formulas**
- ▶ Re-read your finished exam, make any grammar or spelling changes.
- Try all questions, even if in the essay question the most you do is put down some ideas, something is better than nothing.
- ▶ For MATH and SCIENCE exams check your work, <u>have you included any necessary statements?</u>
