## *What is myBlueprint?*


- An engaging, user-friendly, and interactive online education and career planning program

# Introduction

*How is myBlueprint helping Canadian students make the most informed decisions for their future?*

# INQUIRY APPROACH



## Benefits of myBlueprint

- Allows students to showcase their plans, growth, and progress
- Allows students to explore occupations
- Allows students to discover post-secondary opportunities in all four pathways (i.e., Apprenticeships, College, University, and Workplace)

- Mobile friendly & accessible from anywhere!

# The brief tour of a student account looked at the following pages:

- **Dashboard:** brief overview of activities, goals and samples
- **Activities Page:** points collected & prizes
- **High School Page:** plan courses, note credit count
- **Post-Secondary Page:** program search, see overview, visit program website, see requirements for each program
- **Work Page:** occupations, outlook, salary
- **Money Page:** budgets, sample budgets
- **Work Page:** sample resumes and cover letters
- **Who Am I? Page:** surveys to help students know themselves and their learning styles for education and career planning purposes
- **Guides & Articles Page:** lots of information for students and parents

# Courses & Credits

- myBlueprint helps students to keep track of their credits – but it is in the Guidance Office/School Board software where credits are carefully kept/audited for graduation purposes – any discrepancy with myBlueprint and your child’s report cards should be brought to the attention of your child’s Guidance Counsellor
