An Individual Education Plan is a written plan of action. It is a working document which describes the strengths and needs of individual exceptional student and the special education program and services established to meet the student's needs.

What is an IPRC?

IPRC stands for Identification, Placement and Review Committee. The IPRC will: Identify, Place and Review.

- It can decide whether a student should be identified as exceptional
- It can help identify the areas of the student's exceptionality
- It can decide an appropriate placement for the student
- It can review the identification and placement once in a school year
